METHODOLOGY: During the 2021-2022 school year, Gresham-Barlow School District interviewed 1,658 k-12 students, 402 families and staff and conducted a student designed Equity Survey 9th-12th. This is a sampling of the results and the Year One Inclusion Plan for removing barriers and increasing equity across the district.
